ASIAPAC – Severe weather disruptions impacting China to the South Pacific services

Dear Valued Customers,

We wish to advise of delays, capacity issues, and cargo disruptions expected over the coming weeks for our ASIAPAC services from China to the South Pacific via Auckland.

This follows recent severe weather events, including typhoons Maysak and Bavi, as well as further severe weather forecasted for China.

As a result, some Ningbo and Shanghai port calls are being omitted by partner services over July and August:

- OOCL Busan 0706S is omitting Ningbo.
- SC Montruex 0477S is omitting Shanghai.
- Kota Lestari 0285S is omitting Ningbo.
- Xin Zhang Zhou 0078S is omitting Shanghai.

Due to the subsequent backlog of cargo and capacity constraints, any new ASIAPAC bookings will be assigned to the earliest vessel voyage, subject to space availability.

We will continue to closely monitor the situation and update our schedules as we receive the latest information.
