## NZPAC Service – Return of Capitaine Tupaia and phase-in schedule

Dear Valued Customer,

Following our earlier [communication](#) in July, we are pleased to announce the return of the Capitaine Tupaia to our NZPAC service. The service will now return to its normal 21-day rotation with weekly Apia port calls and fortnightly Pago Pago and Nuku'alofa port calls.

To facilitate the smooth transition from our current two loop system to our regular NZPAC rotation, the phase-in process will be as follows:

- NPDL Tahiti 2629 will only perform a northbound rotation from New Zealand to Suva and Lautoka and then phase out of the NZPAC service to return to AUSPAC. All cargo for onward connections will be discharged in Suva.
- Capitaine Tupaia 2629S will phase into NZPAC in Lautoka on 28 August and perform a shortened southbound rotation of Lautoka – Suva – Pago Pago – Tauranga, to meet her berth window.
- Neptune Matua 2630S will omit Pago Pago and only call Apia and Nuku'alofa.
- All Pago Pago destined cargo from the Neptune Matua 2630 and NPDL Tahiti 2629 will be transferred to the Capitaine Tupaia 2629S in Suva.

The updated voyage schedules will be reflected in our next schedule publications and are as follows:
