## **Adverse Weather Conditions impacting NPDL Services**

Dear Valued Customer,

We regret to advise of schedule delays across the NPDL network due to adverse weather conditions affecting Samoa, American Samoa, Tarawa and Norfolk Island.

The impacted vessels are:

- Capitaine Tasman 0502S: At berth in Pago Pago, and operations have been delayed until morning of 20-Feb.
- Capitaine Wallis 417N: At anchorage and awaiting berth in Apia due to port closure. Her arrival in Noumea and commencement of Voy 419 will be delayed.
- **Micronesian Ocean 047N:** At berth in Tarawa, but waiting for weather conditions to improve to resume operations, earliest 20-Feb
- **Norfolk LCT 0501:** Departure from Brisbane delayed to the 19-Feb and will encounter heavy swells enroute delaying her arrival in Norfolk to 26-Feb.

We will closely monitor and update our schedules as we get the latest from the respective ports.
