Another vessel has experienced a crane failure over the weekend and needs to perform repairs before she can safely depart. This recovery plan, is taking up the full berth, leading to delays across all ships to be worked in the Port of Suva.

The PFL Matai was due to arrive and commence work on Sunday October 20<sup>th</sup> but based on current information, is due to berth in the evening of Wednesday October 23<sup>rd</sup>.
